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## Securitisation Templates

*Of particular interest to: originators and sponsors of securitisations*

The Securitisation Regulation (2017/2402) took effect from 1 January 2019 and, amongst other matters, imposed notification obligations on originators, sponsors and securitisation special purpose entities.

Such notifications included Article 27 'STS' designation notifications (that a securitisation meets the criteria for 'simple, transparent and standardised') to ESMA and Article 7 transparency disclosures – e.g. information on the underlying exposures – to investors and potential investors via a securitisation repository.

The regulatory technical standards (**RTS**) and implementing technical standards (**ITS**) containing the templates for these notifications were recently published in the Official Journal.

A statement by ESMA (see 'Useful Links') has confirmed that these templates enter into force on **23 September 2020** and are to be used from that date – any transitional provisions previously applying under Article 43 will no longer apply.
